Ratios and Proportions

BIBLE

Includes an overview of the Old and New Testament, an in-depth personalized study of popular passages, and application of scripture to student related issues.

COMPUTER

Typing programs and word processing skills

HISTORY

New World history and geography includes the exploring of the New World with studies focusing on Middle America, South America, Canada, and the United States.
Interpretation of Lincoln's Gettysburg Address, rights of Americans, United States Presidents and Vice-Presidents.

LANGUAGE

Phonics-based lessons that increase student knowledge of grammar and strengthen speaking and writing skills.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Presidential Physical Fitness Program. Variety of indoor and outdoor games, calisthenics and cardiovascular activity.

READING

Emphasis on non-fiction and historical biographies. Reading for detail and extended comprehension. Appreciation of poetry, literature, plays, and myths.

SCIENCE

Varying aspects of plants, energy, light, matter, earth and space.

SPELLING

Extended study of frequently misspelled words Word building from a root word Word origins / vocabulary
